The Commingling Group agrees to accept commingling of the brands listed by product groups on the attached schedules. In accordance with the Bottle Bill, payment to the Redemption Center for the refund value, deposit and handling fee shall be made by check within 10 business days after acceptance and will not be credited against current deliveries.

The Redemption Center agrees to commingle the brands listed on the attached Schedules A through E according to the option selected and will certify the accuracy of the bag and case counts.

This Contract will automatically terminate upon the termination of the Redemption Center License, unless and until the License is reinstated or renewed by the Department of Agriculture.

SORTING OPTIONS

The Maine Bottle Bill provides that qualifying containers shall be commingled by product group, material and size, without regard to distributor or brand. When adopting the Bottle Bill, the Legislature expressed its intent to enhance the environment, reduce litter and minimize the cost of solid waste disposal. Sorting glass by color is necessary to fulfill the Legislature’s intent to enhance recycling and provides the best option for a reduced number of sorts.

- 7oz, 8.4oz, 10oz, 11.5oz, 11.2oz, 12oz, 200ml 3 colors 24 / 20 / 18 count case
- 14oz, 16oz, 17.5oz- 3 colors 24 count case
- 18.6oz, 18.7oz, 19.25oz, 22oz, 25.4oz, 24oz, 32oz, 33oz, 40oz 3 colors 12 count case

Wine (maximum: 3 sorts)

- Clear • Green • All Other

Cans *(maximum: 4 sorts)*

- 6 – 8.9oz (Bag count 432)
- 9 – 13.9oz (Bag count 324)
- 14 -16.9oz (Bag count 230)
- 17 – 24.9oz (Bag count 168)

Plastic *(maximum: 4 sorts)*

- 14 – 16.9oz (216count bag)
- 17 – 24oz (168 count bag)
- 24.1 oz. to 1.5L (108 count bag)
- 2 Liter (56 count bag)
